

Cover Page

181 208-0 has been one of the first locomotives of this class which was painted oriental red by the Federal Railways of Germany. The model by Rokuhan is shown in front of an international freight train and is still riding on the German side near the border which has a raised pantograph above cabin 1.

January

We are in Norway near the polar circle (layout: Karl Sinn) where we can find snow and ice during the summer also. The electric loco class El 18 owned by the NSB is a Swiss construction class Re 460 adapted to the conditions of the artic climate. We see it while one its rare services in front of a freight train.

Februarv

The "Edelweiß Railway" (named like an Alpine flower) is a fictitious private branch line on the Sägethal layout by Götz Guddas, designed according to impressions from eras II and III. The small loco of former Prussian class T3 is still in use for passenger trains.

March

Circus is coming to town! At the end of the sixties German circus companies were still carried by train. Long freight trains of boxcars and two-axle flat cars announce the arrival of "people's theatre". In front we see a steam loco class 052 with the previously mentioned message written on the smoke deflectors.

April

The wonderful days of cherry blossom in Japan was converted in an artistic way into Z scale by Karl Sinn. As typical as this spring period are the Shinkansen trains series 500 owned by JR West which was realized in an impressing way by Rokuhan.

Mav

E 94 003 is running in its first grey colour of Deutsche Reichsbahn, passing the camping children with a freight train. The loco model was part of a Märklin set celebrating "750 years Berlin". Photo: Andreas Petkelis

June

The pioneering period of German railways is represented by the "Altenbeken" of HAE with a short train realized by Bahls Modelleisenbahnen. On the roads of the 19th century are only horses and carts in use.

July

An EMD GP7 of Chesapeake & Ohio is running with a passenger train of heavyweights, both realized by AZL, through the sand dunes of the Chesapeake Bay, Maryland – a layout designed by Dirk Kuhlmann. Photo: Dirk Kuhlmann

August

In 1998 we look back to ten years of "Starlight Express" musical in Bochum (Germany). Deutsche Bahn AG and Märklin commemorated this anniversary with a special design on the prototype of modern loco 101 001-6 and is models. More than 18 years later there is worldwide no other musical ever presented in the same theater for such a long time.

September

The prototype was unsuccessful and a complete reconstruction only brought a short time in service. But this is different with Märklin's model of 05 003 that was perfectly set in motion by Jens Wimmel on a turntable. Foto: Jens Wimmel

October

The heavy Russian diesel-electric loco class 132 is a reminiscence of the Deutsche Reichsbahn in the former GDR. But this freight train could be identified without any doubt as one coming from Western Germany as the white coloured gas tank cars with orange warning stripes belong to a German wagon rental company. As such the GDR is only a memory today.

November

Beautiful subjects are also offered by the Pennsylvania Railroad. In White Haven we meet the no more well-maintained steam loco 9629 of the PRR (model by AZL) which is working hardly when setting in motion a stock train (models by MTL) to Salisbury. Photo: Dirk Kuhlmann

December

A surprise to Z scale friends was the new item for 2016 of a railbus car class 627 by SMZ based on a chassis of Rokuhan. The red coloured model looks well with a winter wonderland in the background.
