V 188 001 a/b is based at Bw Gemünden in the mid-sixties, which uses the double Diesel locomotive in freight service. When she leans into the curve of a section elegantly with a fast freight train, she even carries a freight train baggage wagon with the Pwgs 41.

January

Only JR West uses the 500 series Shinkansen in Japanese high-speed service. This train's Rokuhan model pulls into the station in the picture, giving a special meaning to the term "as fast as an arrow".

February

Scenic railway romance at the end of the 1950s is a popular layout theme. Back then, the German Federal Railroad could not complain about the number of passengers, as they rush in droves to the passenger train that has just arrived, pulled by a class 94⁵⁻¹⁷ tank engine.

March

The line of grey-white refrigerator cars that 212 152-3 pulls through the station seems endless. Thanks to its sufficient top speed, this light-weight line Diesel locomotive also operates on main lines and perhaps that's why it has captured the hearts of the Zetties that much.

April

The EMD GP38-2 is an American multi-purpose Diesel locomotive and is in service with many railroad companies. Here it is in service with BNSF, the Burlington Northern & Santa Fe, after the merger of the two railroads. For AZL, these models were exceptional, as they marked the starting point for today's brand. Photo: Andreas Petkelis

May

"Tiger" is the name of the locomotive 233 493-6, which is now on the rails for the Bahnbau Group within the Deutsche Bahn AG Group. This locomotive was once built in present-day Ukraine and later found its way to DB AG via the Deutsche Reichsbahn.

June

The Württemberg C 2041 was decorated with the factory number 4000 by Maschinenfabrik Esslingen. In contrast to the original, the Märklin model also comes with its factory decoration on the tracks and runs in express train service as befits its rank.

July

Rarely was the Intercity-Experimental, put into service in 1985 as class 410, on the rails with all three centre coaches. This rare snapshot was taken on the very detailed Alpen layout of our reader. Photo: Eckard Jehle

August

Somewhere between the rivers Rhine and Moselle, in the middle of the German wine-growing regions of the river valleys, which are world-famous for their Riesling, 151 104-7 is on its way with a long unit train at the block station Kammerrund. Photo: Jürgen Wagner

September

Double-deck commuter coaches painted white, the IC2 is ready: as simple as in the original, a long-distance train of the formally second-highest comfort level is also created in the model from familiar types with the least amount of effort. Customer interest at the station is low in the small scale.

October

On 19 October 1977, exactly one week before the end of the steam locomotive era at the DB, it was up to 043 196-5 to bring the last scheduled steam-operated passenger train of the Deutsche Bundesbahn to Rheine. This ride is authentically depicted here in the model.

November

Not every day in November must be gloomy. 155 260-3 from Zmodell in its traffic-red livery provides further splashes of colour in the bright autumn. Apparently, the catenary wire is iced up, because the driver has raised both pantographs for more reliable contact with the traction current.

December

A black beauty is SJ's Rc3 1366, presenting itself to its admirers in the wintry scenery of Sweden. The machines built by Asea first made a career in Austria before returning home. FR Freudenreich Feinwerktechnik has created a memorial to them on a scale of 1:220. Photo: Dirk Kuhlmann
